HOW TO SUBMIT: Prospective authors are invited to submit extended abstracts (500 -- 1500 words) in English by e-mail to addresses below. The extended abstract should be received by July 15, 2003. The plain text format is strongly encouraged. The extended abstract should contain the title, authors' names, affiliations, and keywords (4 - 5 keywords) as well as the information on the correspondence author, i.e., the address, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Each submitted paper will be reviewed for acceptance based on clarity, significance, and originality.

CAMERA-READY FORMAT: The accepted papers will be published in the symposium proceedings. The final camera-ready draft is limited to 4 pages in the standard IEEE double-column paper. The postscript file or pdf of the camera-ready draft should be sent one of the above addresses. Details including Latex stylefiles and MS Word style files in IEEE format will be given at this symposium web page.

INVITED TALKS will be delivered by distinguished researchers in the fields.

CONFERENCE EXCURSION: The conference excursion will take place on Saturday, November 15, 2003.

REGISTRATION FEE: The registration fee will be 20,000 yen (USD 200) and 5,000 yen (USD 50) for students, which includes of proceedings, coffee breaks, welcome party, and excursion. Details of registration will be announced shortly.

CONFERENCE HALL: The symposium will be held at **ACROS Fukuoka** that is located at the center of Fukuoka City, TENJIN. It takes only 15 minutes by the subway from Fukuoka Airport. ACROS means Asian Crossroad Over the Sea, and has a big symphony hall, an international conference hall and related facilities, TAKUMI (art & craft) gallery, international plaza, event halls, and so on. The opening session will be held at the international conference hall with a capacity of 300.
